They rap twice for the second lap, and three times for the third. "We are one of the only organizations where people of different faiths can meet on common ground and not worry about being discriminated against." Opening up to the outside is not really built into the organization, though, and some older members are leary of the group's Internet presence, McCarthy said. The candidate gives the Junior Deacon the password and sign of the first degree, "Boaz" and is gives the password for the third degree.
