Green Bay in the lead, no less)? Those percentages on ESPN are the current win-loss percentages of the teams those squads have already beaten. But remember, to get this far into our scenario, the Lions and Packers finish 9-8; otherwise this tiebreaker doesn't even matter. That means Green Bay defeats teams still on the schedule with good records
(Miami, Minnesota and Detroit). So the strength-of-victory percentages we calculate already assume the Packers and Lions closed with 9-8 records, and they count the records of teams they haven't yet played.
