Thank the speakers. Usually, you will be given an introduction by, perhaps, a master of ceremonies. Address them. Be courteous. You may also like middle school speech examples. Congratulate the wedding couple. Before you proceed to the gory storytelling, don't forget what brought you to that event in the first place. Make a joke about the groom, and then make more jokes about the groom. Read messages from guests who couldn't come. That is, if there are any. Quote a famous line, or a poem, or a song that you think the newly wed can relate to. Propose a toast. Preferably a heart-warming one. Experts advise that a speech should be no longer than 5 minutes. This is enough time to say what you want without boring the audience. Adjust the length depending on the event; for a short Vegas wedding, your speech should be much shorter, but for a formal wedding, you might speak a little longer. Remember, it's their wedding, not yours. Focus on the couple, not yourself. Share memories of the groom, but don't make yourself the hero. Include the bride in your stories and make sure she feels valued. Negativity about Marriage: Avoid expressing cynicism about marriage. This is a celebration of love and commitment. Past Relationships: Never mention ex-girlfriends or flings. It can spoil the mood and upset the bride. Previous Marriages or Divorce: If the groom has been married before, don't bring it up. It's unnecessary and could offend someone. Sensitive Topics: Avoid jokes or stories about drinking, drugs, gambling, or STDs. Remember, there may be children present. Adult Humor: Steer clear of dirty jokes or innuendos, especially about the honeymoon. Keep it clean and respectful. Weddings are joyous occasions, and as the best man, you have an important role. Start writing your speech at least a few weeks before the wedding to allow ample time for revisions and practice. Aim for a speech that lasts between 5 to 7 minutes to keep the audience engaged without overstaying your welcome. Include personal anecdotes, heartfelt sentiments, compliments to the couple, and a touch of humor to entertain the guests. Start with a warm introduction, thanking everyone for being there and briefly mentioning your relationship with the groom. Yes, use appropriate and light-hearted jokes to add humor, but avoid anything that could embarrass or offend the couple or guests. Practice by reading it aloud multiple times, ideally in front of friends or family, to gain confidence and refine your delivery. Memorize the key points but keep a written copy or note cards handy to stay on track during the delivery. Take deep breaths, stay calm, and remember that the audience is supportive and there to celebrate with you. Avoid controversial topics, ex-partners, embarrassing stories, and any remarks that could be deemed offensive or inappropriate.
